

Camp Regulations And Waiver Form

PLEASE PRINT ONE FORM FOR EACH ENROLLING CAMPER.

GMH Enterprises, Inc. dba TenniStar[®], SoccerStar, SportStar, HoopStar, LaxStar, and Create-a-Star Camps reserves the right to dismiss any camper deemed detrimental to the camp. We will not tolerate violent behavior or loud or abusive language directed at instructors or at fellow campers. If such behavior continues over a period of time after warnings have been issued, the camper will be subject to dismissal without refund. Parents will be held liable for damage to school property caused by the reckless behavior of their children.

No refunds or deductions of camp fees will be made for late arrivals or early departures.

GMH Enterprises, Inc. is not responsible for the loss of or damage to personal property of campers. Campers are advised to bring only equipment relevant to the camp's operations and should not bring an excessive amount of money. Campers who lend equipment to other campers do so at their own risk.

Any emotional problems or history of chronic illness, including asthma or allergic reactions, must be reported to both our administrative office and to the head instructor, before the first class.

I have read the regulations and agree to assume complete financial responsibility for any personal injury or property damage created as a result of an intentional or negligent act of my child or ward, while attending **GMH Enterprises, Inc.**, camps, lessons or clinics.
 2. I understand and agree that **GMH Enterprises, Inc.** shall retain the right to dismiss any child whose behavior is detrimental to the normal operation of the camp. No refund will be made in such a case.
 3. To the best of my knowledge, there are no physical or other conditions which will interfere with my child's participation. I certify that my child or ward has had a medical examination within the last twelve months and, in the physician's opinion, is physically capable of completing the **GMH Enterprises, Inc.** session for which he/she has registered.
 4. In case of emergency, if parents, emergency contact or child's physician cannot be reached by phone, I hereby give my consent to **GMH Enterprises, Inc.** and to any agent acting on their behalf to secure and provide any medical treatment that might be necessary in case of injury or sickness, while attending camp. I hereby give permission to the physician selected by **GMH Enterprises, Inc.** to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for, and order injection, anesthesia or surgery for my child or ward as named above. I further agree to accept responsibility for any medical expenses, incurred on behalf of my child or ward under the conditions described above. **I understand that any accident or sickness claim will be covered by the parents' or guardians' insurance policy.**

I hereby waive and release any and all rights and claims I may have against GMH Enterprises, Inc., the St. Andrew's Episcopal School, the Georgetown Visitation Preparatory School, Sport & Health Bethesda, The Audrey Moore RECenter, and their officers, employees and representatives for any and all injuries which may be suffered by my child or ward in connection with his or her participation in camps, lessons or clinics.
